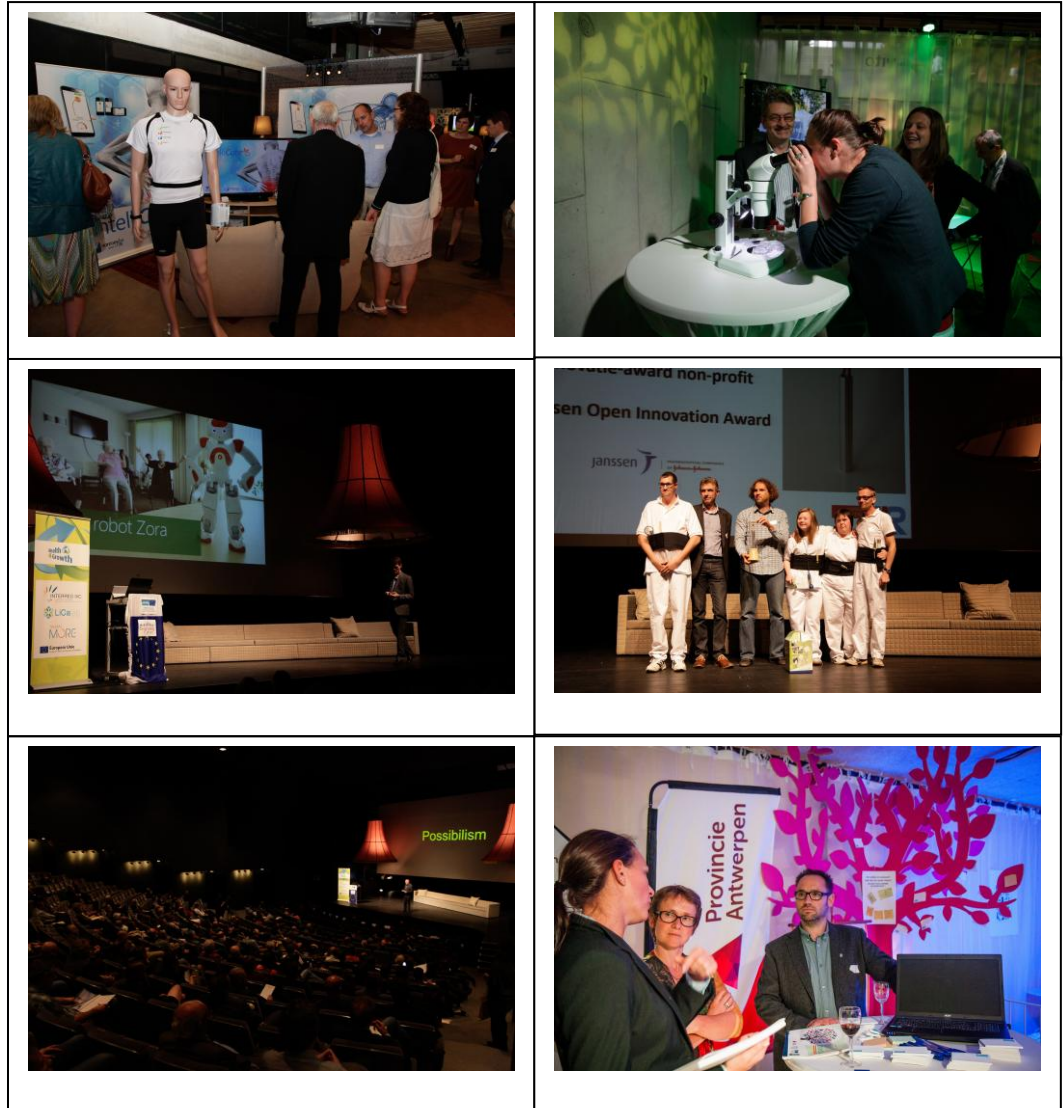
Final event & innovation fair, September 26th
